## TRAVEL

The team will arrive in Tel Aviv on 27 March. They will then set up and meet with the translator.

**28-30 March** - Team orientation, setting up and fellowship with believers in Jerusalem.

**31 March** - Commence Walking The Great Commission near Hebron toward Bethlehem.

**2 April** - Meet with Mayor of Bethlehem and visit/pray over Cross Rhythms Studio and meet with pastors.

**TBC** - Travel by ship from Cape Town to Tristan Da Cunha.

## THE JOURNEY

The team will begin each day in prayer before David heads out onto the road accompanied by a team member and the interpreter, followed by David Lettow who will be doing the photography and a team member who will be the designated driver of the backup car. David will carry his cross and bowl, along with a backpack containing water, towels, a small chair and bibles.

David and the team believe that the Holy Spirit will lead them as they meet people on the road. They will talk to, listen and pray for those they meet. They hope to lead people in a prayer of salvation as they invite Jesus into their hearts. In all this they desire to display the servant love of Jesus.

- Pray that God would give the team joy, wisdom, grace, mercy, love, kindness and more of himself to each of them, that each step they take would bear weight in the spiritual realm for the King and for His Kingdom.
- Pray for their protection and provision as they travel by land, air and sea, particularly out on the road.
- Pray for those who are assisting with translating, transportation, accommodation and other administrative requirements.
- Pray for all the people and churches that are supporting the team, that a full and life changing revelation will happen for each and every one of us, as each of us is called to be His witness.
- Pray that God would go before them, that He would place their hands and feet on a divine and Kingdom changing path.
