THEME SCRIPTURE:

Psalm 107:19-20 (NAS)

'Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble; He saved them out of their distresses. He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions'.

THANKSGIVING:

Psalm 107:3 (NAS)

He has... gathered from the lands, from the east and from the west, from the north and from the south.

- Let us give thanks for the fact that the Lord has called and gathered us from all over the world to be a wonderful family.
- Let us give thanks for the values of His Word and the principles of His Word, which He allows us to walk in Kingdom Fathers and Sons In us the Nations of the Farth will be blessed.

DELIVERED:

The COTN family around the world has been tested during 2020 in a way, unrivaled in generations. We have seen COTN pastors and their families being attacked and, in some cases, succumbing to the pandemic.

Psalm 107:19-21 (NAS)

Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble; He saved them out of their distresses.

- Thank the Lord for being that present help in our adversity.
- He has made us overcomers.

Psalm 107:27

They were at their 'wits end'. The had lost their ability to navigate.

Psalm 107:24 (MESSAGE)

They have seen the works of the Lord, and His wonders in the deep......

25 With a word he called up the wind- an ocean storm, towering waves! You shot high in the sky, then **the bottom dropped out**; your hearts were stuck in your throats. You were **spun like a top, you reeled** like a drunk, **you didn't know which end was up.** Then you called out to GOD in your desperate condition; he got you out in the nick of time.

We've witnessed this with World Leaders during the pandemic this year.

The bottoms of their worlds have dropped out, they have been out of answers and options.

They have spun like tops and reeled.

Leaders have been so disorientated and not know which end was up, not knowing how to navigate.

Thank the Lord:

- That He is sovereign and that He is the King of Kings.
- That He is not confused and knows the beginning from the end.
- That things impossible with man are possible with God.

Psalm 107:29-30 (NAS)

He caused the **storm to be still**, so that the waves of the sea were hushed. Then they were **glad because they were guiet**, So He guided them to **their desired haven**. ...

- God stills the storm
- He brings quiet, for which we give thanks.
- He guides us to our place of peace and blessing. (Our desired place).

He sent His word and HEALED them and DELIVERED.

- Thank the Lord for those in our midst who have been healed He is Jehovah Raphah.
- He is indeed a mighty Deliverer. Thank Him for quelling and Delivering the virus and for bringing it under subjection beneath our feet.

Psalm 22:4-5 (NAS)

In You our fathers trusted; they trusted, and You delivered them. To You they cried out and were delivered; in You they trusted and were not disappointed. ...

• Thank the Lord that He is a Loving Heavenly Father who never disappoints.

Eight times this psalm (107) it mentions God's lovingkindness.

• Let us give thanks to the LORD for His lovingkindness...



Psalm 40:2 (NKJ)

He also brought me up out of a horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and ESTABLISHED my steps.

- God will never just deliver us into nothing, but will always establish us into something far better begin to thank Him for the 'new thing', both in the natural and the Spirit.
