

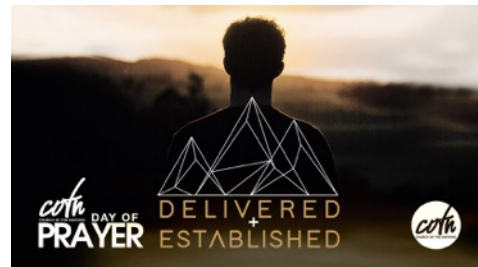

Psalm 107:3 (NAS)

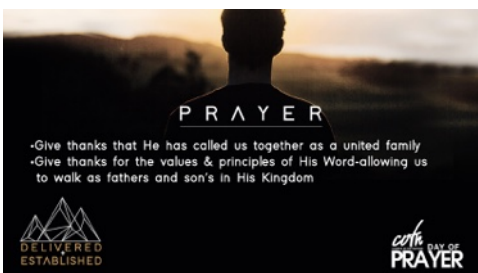
He has... gathered from the lands, from the east and from the west, from the north and from the south.

PRAYER

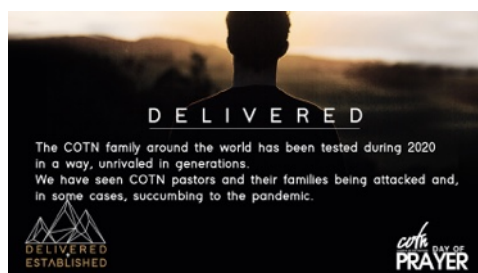
- Give thanks that He has called us together as a united family

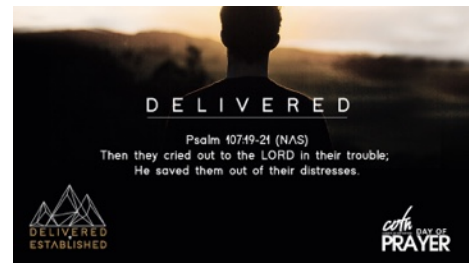

Psalm 107:19-21 (NAS)

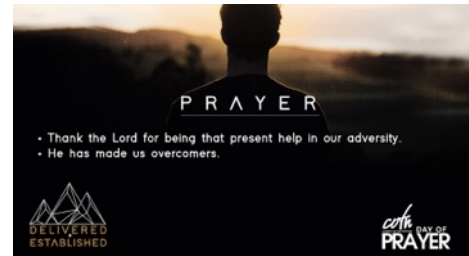

The had lost their ability to navigate.



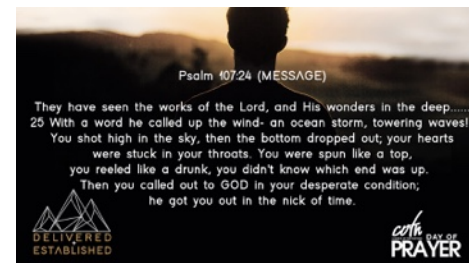
SLIDE9

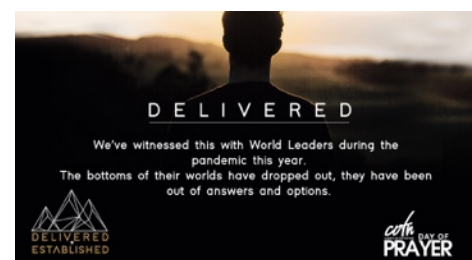


SLIDE10

We've witnessed this with World Leaders during the pandemic this year.

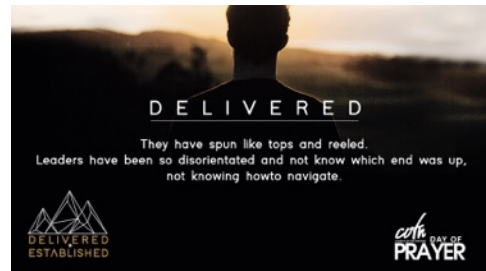
The bottoms of their worlds have dropped out,they have been out of answers and options.

DELIVERED

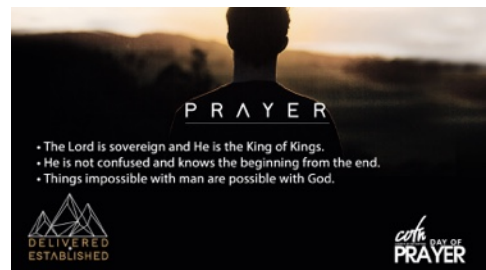
They have spun like tops and reeled.

PRAYER

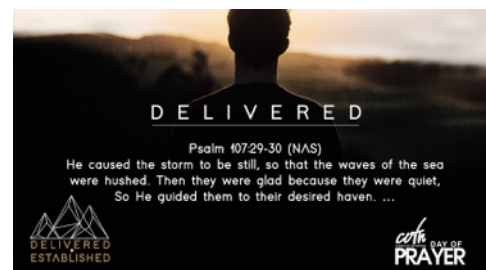
- The Lord is sovereign and He is the King of Kings.

DELIVERED

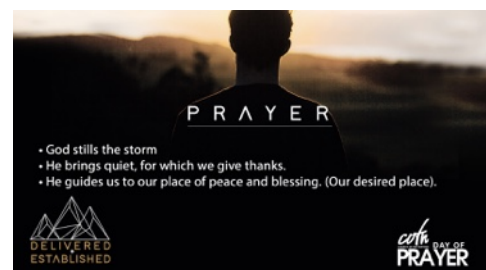
Psalm 107:29-30 (NAS)

- He guides us to our place of peace and blessing. (Our desired place).

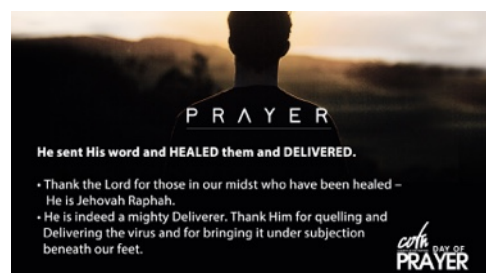


SLIDE15

- He is indeed a mighty Deliverer. Thank Him for quelling and Delivering the virus and for bringing it under subjection beneath our feet.



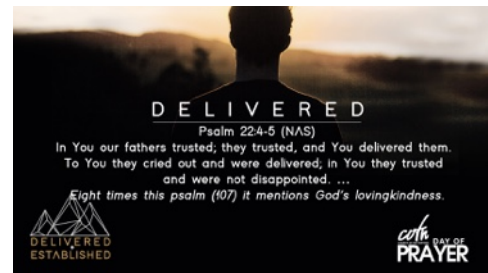
SLIDE16

- Let us give thanks to the LORD for His lovingkindness...

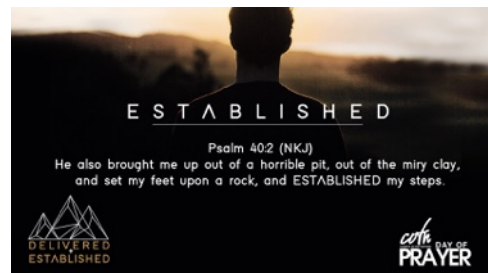


SLIDE18

He also brought me up out of a horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and ESTABLISHED my steps.

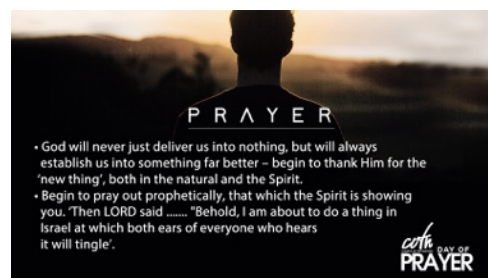


SLIDE19
